i-5 FREEDOM NETWORK

In 2013 Brenda Wells attended an Orange County anti-trafficking event and the wheels were set in motion. Two years later, in 2015, Brenda launched i-5 Freedom Network – an organization borne from her passion for the cause and her professional experience.

Brenda combined her professional experience with her knowledge on human trafficking to combat the activity from a unique vantage point. As a corporate trainer she leveraged her connections in Dale Carnegie to provide free employment training for survivors, who are at a disadvantage when it comes to finding and retaining work. What's more, her experience in and understanding of the hotel industry allowed her to formulate human trafficking prevention training tailored to the needs of the hotel industry. With an engaged Board and dedicated team, i-5 Freedom Network has become an integral part of the healing process for human trafficking survivors throughout Orange County and the surrounding area.



Our programs bring together survivors and support services providers participating together in a simulated working environment.


This gives Survivors an opportunity to see positive role models and to "work together" with directors and case managers from other anti human trafficking organizations who provide them with affirmation and encouragement.

Support services providers have expressed increased empathy and admiration towards survivors who they serve as an additional benefit from our program.


#### PARTICIPANTS BACKGROUND:

#### PARTICIPANTS EMPLOYMENT STATUS:




### WAY2WORK PROGRAMS responses

#### **SKILLS FOR SUCCESS**

Provides interpersonal communication skills to improve confidence upon completion of the Skills for Success course:

 57% of participants rated their self confidence between 3-6 out of 10 upon the start of our program.

 100% Participants expressed they had an increase in confidence as a result of the program.





- 100% of participants strongly agreed that their people skills improved as a result of this program.
- 82% of participants strongly agreed their confidence increased as a result of this training


### We asked our participants why they enrolled. Here's a few of their responses.


#### HIGH IMPACT PRESENTATIONS COURSE

## EMPOWERING SURVIVORS: NEW SURVIVOR PROGRAMS

#### Way2Work Plus

Way2Work Plus continued and expanded this year. Through a generous grant, 16 participants have received one or more of the following::

- · A new computer;
- A one-on-one consultation with our Stylist consultant, to advise them on their professional style and help them select a new business outfit;
- A gas gift card, to help them cope with the increased gas prices so they can go to their job location or job interviews.

#### **Inspiration Café**

"Inspiration Cafe" is the name of our newly formed online support groups for our English and Spanish speaking Alumni, where graduates of our programs reconnect once a month, meet other graduates, discuss topics of interest, find support and enjoy time with people who understand.

We are honored to open this space where our graduates can turn to for support and guidance; This is also a platform for them to be the spotlight as the "Guest speaker" of the session, on a topic they have experience with, further developing their confidence, leadership and public speaking skills.

"I have NO other circle. The circle I had was traumatic, full of drama. I realize I have no one to talk to about the things that I am going through."



### **COMMUNITY AWARENESS**

- Brenda Wells, Founder and Executive Director of i-5 Freedom Network was a key contributor in the four-part Susan Samueli Foundation Event,
- i-5 Freedom Network was featured in the Unite US- California Partner Spotlight Event.
- i-5 Freedom Network was a guest on the Anti-Human Trafficking Spanish podcast "Terminando con la Trata." (Ending Human Trafficking), a podcast heard in the US and in over 50 countries!
- i-5 Freedom Network organized and hosted a special San Clemente Town Hall Event to address Human Trafficking in our area that was attended by more than 60 members of the community.
- i-5 Freedom Network organized and hosted a local soiree event to bring our work and awareness to the local community

### HOTEL READINESS

- i-5 Freedom Network hosted a Community and Safety Event training countering increased activity of human trafficking during local Superbowl events
- i-5 Freedom Network and 13 local anti-trafficking organizations, joined resources to combat human trafficking during the 2022 Super Bowl.
- A volunteer team of 11 spent a collective 50+ hours delivering printed resources to 65 different hotels and motels.
- i-5 Freedom Network launched "The Levi Project", a new training and awareness initiative for responding to possible trafficking incidences.
- i-5 Freedom Network initiated and developed a compliance and rating program for local hotels to award proactive efforts to eliminate human trafficking in the hospitality industry.




